- 10:30-12:30 - **Guided tour of Winchester** – Follow the same pink petals that participants in the Shenandoah Apple Blossom Festival parade follow, while our guide entertains with stories and shows some of Winchester's most beautiful homes, the POW-MIA Memorial, Abram's Delight, Stonewall Jackson's Headquarters, George Washington's Office & Statue, Glen Burnie, the grave of Country Music Legend Patsy Cline and more.
- 12:45-2:15 - Enjoy a delicious served lunch at **Wayside Inn**, the oldest continuously operated inn in America. Lunch will consist of a house salad, rolls & butter, the inn's famous roasted chicken, potato, vegetable, dessert and beverage. Take time to walk around the inn and see all of the interesting rooms and antiques.
- 2:30-4:00 - Take a guided tour of **Belle Grove Plantation**, an authentic 1797 Manor House and National Historic Landmark which was built by Major Isaac Hite and his wife Nelly Madison Hite, sister of President James Madison.
- 4:15-5:30 - Tour the historic **Patsy Cline House**, the home where Patsy lived during the formative years of her career. Walk where Patsy walked, see where she lived and slept, and hear stories about Patsy's brief life.
