- **Haines Shoe House** (Hallam, PA) – Take a personal tour of the Shoe House which was built in 1948 by "Colonel" Mahlon N. Haines, who was known as the Shoe Wizard of York. View the interesting rooms on five different levels which contain three bedrooms, two baths, a kitchen and living room. The building, modeled after a high-topped work shoe, was originally used as a guest house in addition to being a giant structural advertisement. The shoe motif is everywhere--from the design of the stained glass windows to the shoe-shaped dog house and the decoration on the wooden fence that surrounds the property.
